

# Shopping Cart Liner

This is the perfect gift for anyone that has kids that they take shopping!

## Sewing Supplies:

Three toys

1/2 yard Each of Two Fabrics

1/4 yard for Coupon Pocket

Fusible Batting the same size as the fabric

One Package Wide Single Fold Bias Tape

1/4 yard Extra Fabric for Pillow

1/8 yard for Toy Straps

Fasturn Tube Turner #140000001

1/4" Wide Steam-A-Seam 2

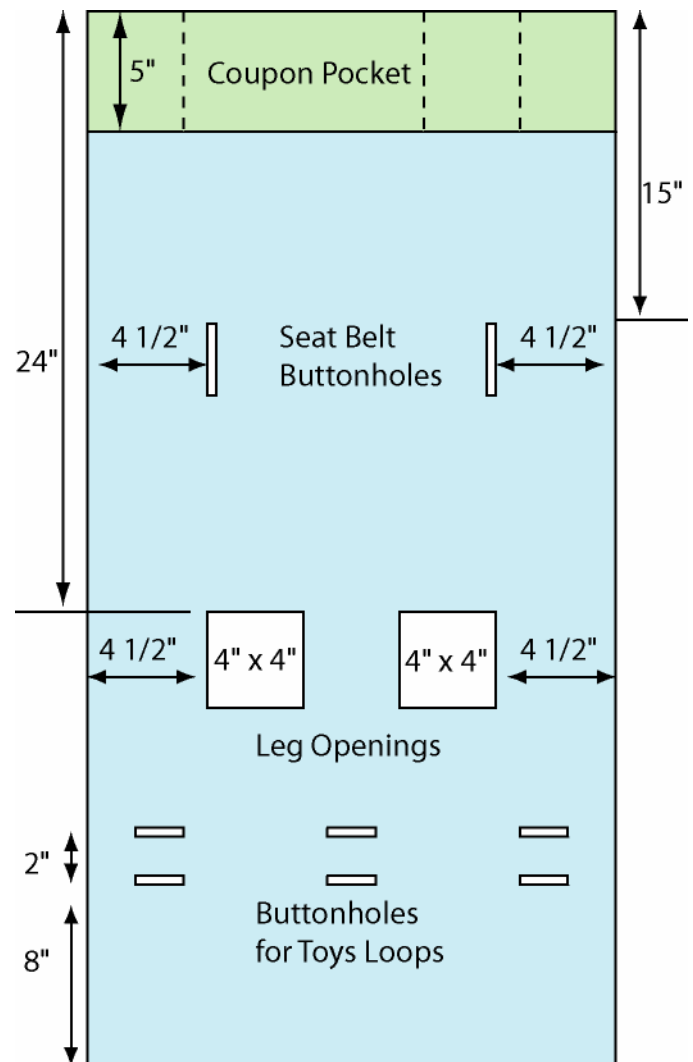
10" Velcro® Sew On Hoop and Loop Tape

One Yard Webbing and Buckle for Seat Belt

Clear 5/8" Seam Guide Foot #413 03 48-45

## Sew:

1. Place the 1/2 yard pieces of two fabrics right sides together. Fuse the fusible batting to the lining. Sew all the way around.
2. Following the diagram at the right, mark leg holes. Cut x in the middle. Snip into the corners. Cut on the lines through all the layers. Turn the liner right side out through through one of the leg holes. Press.
3. Using bias tape, bind the leg holes. Open out the bias tape and on the lining side, pin it around the hole. Select a straight stitch. Stitch in place, following the fold in the bias tape. Bring around to the right side. Select a zig zag and stitch the bias tape in place.



4. Make straps for the toys. Cut three pieces 2 1/2" x 10 1/2". Fold lengthwise, right sides together and stitch both ends and the long side leaving an opening in the middle of the long side for turning. Turn using a Fasturn Tube and press. Insert Steam-A-Seam 2 in the opening and press with steam to fuse. Stitch a 2" Velcro® hook side to one end of the strap and the loop side to the other end of the strap. To attach the toys, stitch buttonholes in the cart liner as shown, following the diagram. Stitch two 30mm Sensor One Step buttonholes separated by 2" for each strap.
5. Stitch two size 32mm buttonholes for seat belt following diagram for placement.
6. Cut two pocket pieces the width of your panel plus 1/2" for seam allowances x 5" wide. Place right sides together and stitch, leaving a 4" opening for turning. Turn, press. Place on the end following the diagram, and topstitch in place.
7. Make a pillow from two pieces of fabric `15" x 9". Before stitching the pieces together, sew Hook and Loop tape to the right side of the pillow back. Stitch three sides and turn. Fill with fiber fill and stitch the fourth side closed. Stitch hook and loop tape to the cart liner about 4" from the pocket to correspond to the hook and loop tape on the pillow.
